St Andrew Goldfields Ltd. ("SAS" or the "Company"), is a Canadian based gold mining, and exploration Company focussed on developing its operations in the Timmins Camp, Northeastern Ontario, Canada, which lies within the world famous Abitibi greenstone belt.

SAS' initial focus is to return producer status by bringing three past producing mines into production by the end of 2010. The Holloway Mine has already begun production in October 2009, the Hislop Project, an open pit operation, has commenced development work to bring it into production during the second quarter of this year, followed by the Holt Mine in the latter half of the year. SAS will also commence exploration drilling on a number of exciting targets within the area. With the existing infrastructure in place (permits, Holt mill with a 3,000 tpd capacity, two fully constructed underground mines, access roads, and power) and a dedicated and experienced team, SAS is poised for success.
